CALL THE MEETING TO ORDER:

ORDINANCES

- a) 2nd reading of an ordinance for the City of Manchester, Tennessee amending Budget Ordinance No. 1743 for FY 2025-2026; sponsored by Alderman Crosslin. Alderman Anderson made a motion to approve and seconded by Alderman Crosslin. Mayor Hobbs opened the floor to a public hearing. After none, Mayor Hobbs called for the roll. The ordinance passed second and final reading 6-0.
- b) 2nd reading of an ordinance of the City of Manchester, Tennessee, adopting a budget for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2027; sponsored by Mayor Hobbs. Vice Mayor Messick made a motion to approve and seconded by Alderman Crosslin. Mayor Hobbs opened the floor to a public hearing. After none, Mayor Hobbs called for the roll. The ordinance passed second and final reading 5-1 with Alderman Anderson voting nay.
- c) 2nd reading of an ordinance amending provisions to Manchester Municipal Code 1-111 regarding Citizens Comments; sponsored by Alderman Crosslin. Alderman Anderson made a motion to approve and seconded by Vice Mayor Messick. Mayor Hobbs opened the floor to a public hearing. Mayor Hobbs called for the roll and the ordinance passed second and final reading 6-0.

ADJOURNMENT: Alderman French made a motion to adjourn and seconded by Vice Mayor Messick. The motion passed 6-0.
