

ORDINANCE NO. 1611

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND MANCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE 10-206 RELATIVE TO IMPOUND FEES

Whereas the City of Manchester currently imposes impound fees for impounding animals which are found running at large; are vicious or otherwise subject to impound; and

Whereas these fees do not defray the costs of impounding the animals; and

Whereas the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Manchester, Tennessee believes it necessary to adjust these fees so that the City recover more of its costs of impoundment from those whose animals are repeatedly impounded.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that there be added between the first and second sentences of Code 10-206 the following sentence:

“After two impoundments in a calendar year, measured from the first impoundment, the impoundment fee shall increase Fifty Dollars (\$50) above the immediately-preceding impound fee.”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that this ordinance shall take effect on and after its publication and passage, the public welfare of the City of Manchester, Tennessee requiring it.
