

**CITY OF MANCHESTER
STREET COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

The Street Committee of the City of Manchester met in regular session on Thursday, March 12, 2026 at 4:30 pm.

Present: Vice Mayor Messick, Alderman Crosslin, Public Works Assistant Director Moore, Director Gannon, John (Manchester Times), Mayor Hobbs. Codes Director Fiske, and citizen

First item was roll call. Vice Mayor Messick, Alderman Crosslin, Mayor Hobbs

Second item was to approve the meeting agenda. Motion to approve made by Alderman Crosslin, Second by Vice Mayor Messick. Passed 2-0

Third item was to approve minutes from February meeting. Motion to approve made by Alderman Crosslin, Second by Vice Mayor Messick. Passed 2-0

Fourth item discussed was comments from citizens. There was none

Fifth item discussed Title 17-102 in Municipal Codes Book. Codes Director Fiske spoke on this. Codes Director Fiske is to write a new code for the Municipal Code Book. There was some further discussion on this. This will need to be taken before the Policy and Procedures Committee in March.

Sixth item discussed was Republic Services. Mayor Hobbs spoke on this. Republic Service will be giving the City of Manchester a refund on the CPI charge. There was some further discussion on this.

Seventh item discussed was the Safety Traffic Study. Mayor Hobbs spoke on this. This would be a grant that the city would need to apply for. The study would help with traffic accidents and it would also help with public safety. There was some further discussion on this. Motion made by Alderman Crosslin to send resolution to the Board of Mayor and Alderman for approval, Second by Vice Mayor Messick. Passes 2-0

Eighth item was department updates. Director Gannon gave update on the sidewalks. He stated that the street dept was still working on Oakdale St and Hills Chapel Rd sidewalks. He stated that one of his employees will be retiring at the end of March. Also, they have widened the end of Rogers Dr at Hills Chapel Rd and they are planning on widening the other end of Rogers Dr at Royal Trail.

Ninth item was other items of interest. Vice Mayor Messick asked about the bridge on Woodland St. He stated it was in bad shape. Director Gannon stated that it was on the list to be milled and paved. Until then we will keep a check on it and cold patch the holes.
