## **City of Manchester**


### **February 18, 2025**


The Manchester City Finance Committee held its regularly called meeting on February 18th, at 4:00 p.m. in the board room at Manchester City Hall.

- 1) The meeting was called to order by Alderman Crosslin, Chairman of the committee.
- 2) On a motion from Mayor Hobbs, seconded by Alderman Crosslin item #8 the Facility Manager position for Parks & Rec was removed. The remaining agenda items were approved by the full Committee as written.
- 3) On a motion made by Alderman Parsley, seconded by Vice-Mayor Messick, the minutes of the January 21st Finance Committee Meeting were approved.
- 4) There were no public comments.
- 5) The Police Department has requested to purchase a Ford Explorer from County EMA. After discussion a motion from Alderman Parsley to approve the purchase was made, and then seconded by Vice-Mayor Messick. Motion passed.
- 6) The Police Department submitted a request to replace their current set of firearms at a cost of \$47,000. After consideration Alderman Parsley made a motion to approve, seconded by Vice Mayor Messick. Motion passed.
- 7) The Committee discussed a proposed move of the Codes Department from City Hall over to a leased building at the corner of Woodland and Hwy 41. After some debate a motion was made by Vice -Mayor Messick and seconded by Alderman Crosslin to approve the move and lease the building. The lease has been sent to the City Attorney for revisions and approval. Motion passed.
- 8) Item removed.
- 9) The Water & Sewer Department has requested to purchase two additional trucks. The issue was discussed without any objections. On a motion by Alderman Parsley , and seconded by Vice-Mayor Messick the purchase was approved.
- 10) There were no items added.

11) The last item was for adjournment. Motion made by Alderman Crosslin, and seconded by Vice-Mayor Messick. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned @ 4:21pm.




