

**CITY OF MANCHESTER
STREET COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**

The Street Committee of the City of Manchester met in a session on Thursday, October 12, 2023 at 5:30 pm.

Present for the meeting were: Alderman Messick, Alderman Anderson, Public Works Director Gannon, Office Manager Moore, Alderman Bellamy, City Engineer Scot St John, Kayla Transue

First item discussed was to approve the minutes. Motion made by Alderman Bellamy to approve the minutes, Second by Alderman Messick Passed 3-0

Second item was comments from citizens. None

Third item discussed were sanitation credits. One customer wants a credit for 3 years and the other customer wants a credit for 4 years. . The committee would like for Director Gannon to get in touch with Republic Services and see if they would be willing to credit the money back to the customers, if not then the Street Dept will send up a credit for 3 months to the Water Dept. There was some further discussion. Alderman Anderson would like to see the Street Dept put a policy in place for this. Motion made by Alderman Messick to send up a credit for 3 months for these two accounts if Republic Services says no, Second by Alderman Bellamy Passed 3-0

Fourth item discussed was sidewalks on Hillschapel Rd. Alderman Anderson talked to the committee about the maybe the sidewalks curving around the trees instead of cutting them down. Alderman Bellamy would like to see what comes back from the letters. There was some further discussion on this.

Fifth item discussed was street lighting and sidewalks on Hospitality Blvd. Ms. Kayla Transue stated she is seeing a lot of the customers walking to the restaurants from the hotels. Director Gannon stated that years ago there was a wiring problem with the lights in the medium. There was some further discussion on this. Director Gannon is to get a price on how much it would cost to get the lights fixed.

Sixth item discussed was animal control. Animal Control Officer Brandon has put in his notice. His last day is October 20, 2023. This job is being advertise inside the city at this time. Director Gannon would like for the job description to be changed from having a CDL to just a regular driver's license. Motion made by Alderman Bellamy to change the description form a CDL to Drivers License, Second by Alderman Messick Passed 3-0

Seventh item was other items of interest:

- Leaf Season starts on October 22, 2023
- The ditch on Skinner Flat and Ester Ln is complete
- The Street Dept has 3 job openings at this time
