

ORDINANCE NO. 1625

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND MANCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 7-505
RELATIVE TO USE OF FIREWORKS**

WHEREAS Manchester Municipal Code 7-505 currently provides for limited use of fireworks in the City of Manchester in periods encompassing certain Federal holidays; and

WHEREAS the United States Congress recently adopted a new Federal holiday, June Nineteenth (19th); and

WHEREAS the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Manchester believes it in the interest of the City of Manchester to expand the period during which use of fireworks is permitted to include the newly adopted Federal holiday.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that Manchester Municipal Code 7-505 be amended to delete “June 20th” and substitute therefore “June 17th.”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that this ordinance shall take effect on and after its publication and passage, the public welfare of the City of Manchester, Tennessee requiring it.
