

ORDINANCE NO. 1651

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CODE SECTION 8-215 OF MANCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS Manchester Municipal Code 8-215 currently sets forth permitted hours of sale for beer; and

WHEREAS the current hours of sale set forth therein are different than the hours applicable to licensees which have a license issued; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to T.C.A. 57-5-113, those licensees of the City who also have a permit for on premises sale of alcoholic beverages issued by the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission may also sell beer for on premises consumption at hours set by the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to T.C.A. 57-3-404, those licensees having a license from the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission for package sales of alcoholic beverages may also sell beer without a separate license from the City during hours established by the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission; and

WHEREAS the current permitted hours of sale set forth in Manchester Municipal Code 8-215 conflict with the hours established by the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission creating a competitive disadvantage; and

WHEREAS the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes there should be uniformity of hours of permitted sales.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that Manchester Municipal Code 8-215 be amended to provide:

“8-215 HOURS OF SALE

Any permittee of the City having a permit for sale of beer for on premises consumption may sell beer for on premises consumption at any time when a permittee of the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission having a permit for sales for on premises consumption (liquor by the drink) may lawfully make sales for on premises consumption.

Any permittee of the City having a permit for sale of beer for off premises consumption may sell beer for off premises consumption at any time where a permittee of the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission having a permit for sale for off premises consumption of alcoholic beverages may lawfully sell beer.”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF
THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that this ordinance shall take effect on and after
its publication and passage, the public welfare of the City of Manchester, Tennessee requiring it.
