

**ORDINANCE NO. 1677**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND MANCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE 14-101 RELATIVE  
PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP**

WHEREAS Manchester Municipal Code 14-101 created the Manchester Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS the Manchester Planning Commission was previously designated a Regional Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS it has recently come to the attention of the Board of Mayor and Alderman that there is a requirement to have two members of the Commission to reside within the Urban Growth when the Commission is acting as a Regional Planning Commission and the City of Manchester believes it to be in the best interest of the City to revise its code to reflect such.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that Manchester Municipal Code 14-101 be amended to delete the current wording and to add the following:

**‘Pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated, Chapter 13, there is hereby created a municipal planning commission, hereinafter referred to as the planning commission. The planning commission shall consist of seven(7) members; two(2) of these shall be the mayor and an alderman selected by the board of mayor and aldermen; the other five(5) members shall be appointed by the mayor; in addition, when acting as a regional planning commission, the commission shall consist of two (2) additional members, appointed by the Mayor, who shall reside within the urban growth boundary. All members of the planning commission shall serve without compensation. The terms of the mayor and the alderman selected by the board of mayor and aldermen shall run concurrently with their terms of office. The terms of all of the seven(7) members appointed by the mayor shall be for five (5) years each, with the term of office of one member on the municipal planning commission ending each year. The mayor, at the first regular meeting after the adoption of the provisions in this section, in order to carry out the provisions of this section as to members from within the urban growth boundary, shall designate the expiration dates of the terms of the newly appointed members. Any vacancy in an appointive membership shall be filled for the unexpired term by the mayor.’**

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that this ordinance shall take effect on and after its publication, passage and public hearing, the public welfare of the City of Manchester, Tennessee requiring it and that all ordinances in conflict be repealed to the extent of this conflict.
