

ORDINANCE NO. 1704

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND MANCHESTER MUNICIPAL CODE 9-202,  
EXEMPTIONS**

WHEREAS Manchester Municipal Code 9-202, creates exemptions to the General Rules for Peddlers and Solicitors in the City of Manchester and;

WHEREAS the Board of Mayor and Alderman feel it appropriate to amend some wording in the exemptions to the code and;

WHEREAS the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes that amending the code is in the best interest of the Citizens of Manchester.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the current Manchester Municipal Code 9-202 be amended to delete it in its entirety and add the following language:

**“9-202. Exemptions. The terms of this chapter shall neither apply to persons selling at wholesale to dealers, nor to newsboys, nor to bona fide merchants who merely deliver goods in the regular course of business, nor to persons selling agricultural products, who, in fact themselves produced the products being sold, nor to sales inside the fenced area at the Coffee County Fairgrounds. The permit under this chapter shall not be required for operations conducted solely on the first weekend of October.**

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that this ordinance shall take effect on and after its publication and passage, the public welfare of the City of Manchester, Tennessee requiring it.
