

RESOLUTION NO. 43-2021

A RESOLUTION TO INSTALL SIDEWALKS IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS the City of Manchester has a number of City streets; and

WHEREAS the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Manchester, Tennessee believe it beneficial to the citizens of the City of Manchester to construct sidewalks along certain City streets; and

WHEREAS, after significant study, the Board determines that the following areas should have priority:

Along Hills Chapel Road from Oak Drive to Forrestwood Drive
Along Coffee Street from Spring Street to State Highway 55
Along Oakdale Street from Wiley Street to Freedom Drive
Along Madison Street from U.S. Highway 41 to Coffee Street
Along Oak Drive from Highway 55 to Hills Chapel Road

and

WHEREAS the estimated cost of these sidewalks is Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000);

and

WHEREAS Manchester Municipal Code Section 5-703(4) of the City of Manchester requires any obligation of the City on any contract in excess of \$35,000 be approved by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that, subject to arrangements for funding, the City of Manchester install sidewalks in the following areas:

Along Hills Chapel Road from Oak Drive to Forrestwood Drive
Along Coffee Street from Spring Street to State Highway 55
Along Oakdale Street from Wiley Street to Freedom Drive
Along Madison Street from U.S. Highway 41 to Coffee Street
Along Oak Drive from Highway 55 to Hills Chapel Road

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that these sidewalks be constructed by City personnel or submitted for bid as the magnitude of each project and availability of City personnel dictates.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the funding for these projects be obtained

from either capital outlay notes or capital bonds as may be the most efficient which shall be separately addressed by subsequent action of the Board.
