

RESOLUTION NO. 44-2021

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THAT ALL AMERICAN RECOVERY PLAN ACT OF 2021 (ARP) FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE CITY BE USED FOR WATER AND WASTEWATER INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS the City of Manchester anticipates receipt of certain ARP funds; and

WHEREAS the State of Tennessee, through its various Departments, will match the portion of said funds the City uses for water and wastewater infrastructure improvements; and

WHEREAS designation that the ARP funds be used for wastewater infrastructure improvements would double the City's benefit from the ARP funds; and

WHEREAS the City's current Wastewater Treatment Plant currently operates at approximately 60% of capacity; and

WHEREAS the City anticipates the need to increase wastewater capacity due to anticipated residential growth; and

WHEREAS the City recently annexed approximately Six Hundred (600) acres which may ultimately need wastewater service; and

WHEREAS the City of Manchester periodically receives inquiries regarding its capacity to provide wastewater service to industries contemplating location in the City or adjacent thereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the City of Manchester, Tennessee commit and designate any and all funds received pursuant to the American Recovery Plan Act of 2021 to water and wastewater infrastructure upgrades.
