

RESOLUTION NO. 36-2022

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AN AGREEMENT FOR A TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND CONSERVATION LOCAL PARKS AND RECREATION FUND GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$750,000, WHICH REQUIRES A ONE HUNDRED PERCENT MATCH FROM THE CITY OF MANCHESTER FOR FIELD LIGHT RENOVATIONS AT FRED DEADMAN AND DAVE KING PARKS

WHEREAS the City of Manchester operates extensive recreation facilities; and

WHEREAS the City of Manchester held a public meeting addressing the recreation needs of the community on November 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS suggestions at the public meeting were renovation of lighting at Dave King and Fred Deadman Park ball-fields; and

WHEREAS there are now Local Parks and Recreation Fund Grants available to fund some of the cost of these improvements; and

WHEREAS the City of Manchester has received a bid for the renovation to the lighting in the amount of One Million, Four Hundred and Ninety Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,495,000.00) and has been approved by the State of Tennessee to receive a Local Parks and Recreation Fund Grant in the amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000), which would require matching funds by the City in the amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000).

WHEREAS Manchester Municipal Code 5-703(4) requires any obligation exceeding \$35,000 be approved by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the City of Manchester contract for a Local Parks and Recreation Fund Grant in the amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000), which would require matching funds by the City in the amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000) to cover the costs of renovation to Ballfield lighting in the amount of One Million, Four Hundred and Ninety Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,495,000.00)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that any resolution inconsistent herewith, including, but not limited to, any resolution restricting spending be amended to allow payment of the City's obligation under this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the Mayor and Finance Director are authorized to execute the necessary documents to contract for this grant.
