

**RESOLUTION NO. 02-2023**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING LEXINGTON CIRCLE AND BLUEGRASS ROAD IN LEXINGTON SUBDIVISION AS CITY STREETS**

WHEREAS the plats of Lexington Subdivision, which are of record as Plats 601A, 738B, 656B, 611B, 651B and 661A, Register's Office of Coffee County, Tennessee, identify proposed streets named "Lexington Circle," and "Bluegrass Road" which lie within the City of Manchester, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS said streets have been inspected by the City's Engineer, Zoning Director, and the Director of Public Works and found to meet the minimum requirements for acceptance by the City; and

WHEREAS the Manchester Regional Planning Commission has recommended acceptance by the City, as contemplated by Title 16, Chapter 3 of the Manchester Municipal Code, as reflected in the minutes of its meeting of December 19, 2022; and

WHEREAS the owners of said streets have executed and delivered a Quitclaim Deed to the City conveying their interest in said streets to the City of Manchester.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the street depicted and described as "Lexington Circle" and "Bluegrass Road" on the plats of record as Plats 601A, 738B, 656B, 611B, 651B and 661A, Register's Office of Coffee County, Tennessee, be accepted as City streets, that they be entered upon the City street list, and that they be named "Lexington Circle" and "Bluegrass Road" respectively.
