

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE AND COFFEE COUNTY, TENNESSEE FOR THE COORDINATION OF ROAD MAINTENANCE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES

WHEREAS the City of Manchester, Tennessee is annexing certain non-adjoining land within in its Urban Growth Boundary (UGB), and

WHEREAS the City of Manchester, Tennessee and Coffee County Tennessee, wish to enter into an Interlocal Agreement for the City of Manchester to provide Emergency Protection and other services upon request, between current City boundaries and the newly annexed property as required by T.C.A. 6-51-104, pursuant to the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit

“A,” that was recently approved by the Coffee County Commission, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the City of Manchester, Tennessee enter into the attached agreement with Coffee County, Tennessee, to provide certain services pursuant to T.C.A. 6-51-104

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE that the Mayor is authorized to execute this agreement.

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, TENNESSEE AND COFFEE COUNTY, TENNESSEE

This agreement made and entered into on this 8 day of July, 2026 between the City of Manchester, Tennessee hereinafter referred to as "City" and Coffee County, Tennessee, hereinafter referred to as "County" pursuant to the provisions of Tennessee Code Annotated (T.C.A. § 6-51-104).

In consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree:

1. The term of this agreement is July, 8, 2026 through July, 7, 2027. This agreement shall automatically renew itself on an annual basis unless canceled in writing proceeded with a six (6) months notice. Either party may cancel this agreement at anytime after providing a six (6) months written notice.
2. Amendments to this agreement must be in writing and approved by the governing boards of the City and County.
 - The City agrees to provide emergency services, including police and fire protection, if requested to the parcels along Cat Creek Road between the Manchester City limits and Parcels 008.13 and 008.14 on Map 086 (the subject of a recent non-contiguous annexation by the City). It is agreed and assumed that the government entities currently responsible for the relevant road maintenance between the above described properties will continue to maintain said responsibility.
3. The County releases the City, and the City releases the County to the extent allowable by law, from any and all liability arising out of terms of this agreement.
4. This agreement shall be approved by the governing body of the City and the governing body of the County. Such agreements shall be in writing and shall authorize the City and County Mayors to sign the agreement.
